I. JACOB, THE SELF-MADE MAN

- A. RECAP: Jacob's life thus far: chasing and crashing (his deception/discipline)
- B. Jacob's attempts to appease Esau—his deceptive tendencies return in crisis (32:1-8, 13-21)
- C. Jacob's prayer to God—his manipulative tendencies rise to the forefront. (32:9-12)

II. ISRAEL, THE RE-MADE MAN

- A. Jacob's recognition that he was **grappling** with God and **clinging** to God for blessing. (32:24-26)
- B. God's renaming of Jacob: "Israel" means "God fights [for you]". (32:27-29)
- C. Jacob will never have to fight again; he will never be able to fight again. (32:30-32)

III. CLING TO GOD ALONE!

A. How we can live in confidence, seeking only God for our blessing, remembering He fights for us.

B' Jacob crosses as the sun rises (32:31a)
A' Jacob limps on his thigh (32:31b)
