I. THE RISE OF EVIL

- A. Jacob blessed (Gen. 32) & reconciled (Gen. 33)
- B. Introduction of evil: The **<u>rape</u>** of Dinah (34:1-4)
- Jacob's <u>lack</u> of response is evidence of apathy in the face of evil. (34:5-19)

II. THE RESULT OF EVIL

- A. Evil <u>begets</u> evil: the response of Jacob's sons.
 (34:20-29)
- B. Jacob's <u>lack</u> of response, and his self-concern (34:30-31)
- III. REACT TO EVIL!
 - A. How to think, speak, and act in the face of evil in our midst.

THE FOUR SCENES OF 34:1-31

A Jacob's daughter violated (34:1-4) Speech to father: "Take for me this young girl as a wife" (34:4) Concludes with word from son to father (34:4)

B Hamor & Shechem propose marital alliance with Jacob's family (34:5-19)

Terms accepted (34:18); unit begins with "hear" (34:5); "go out" (34:6)

B' Hamor & Shechem propose marital alliance to their fellow-townsfolk (34:20-24)

Terms accepted (34:24); unit ends with "hear" (34:24); "go out" (34:24)

A' Jacob's sons violate the town (34:25-31)
 Speech to father: "Should he treat our sister as a harlot?" (34:31)
 Concludes with word from sons to father (34:31)
