Matt. 28:1-15; 1 Pet. 1:3-4; Rom. 10:9-11

SERMON OUTLINE

I. HE IS NOT THERE; HE IS RISEN! (MATT. 28:1-15)

- A. They thought Jesus was dead. (28:1)
- B. They heard Jesus was <u>alive</u>. (28:2-8)
- C. They saw Jesus personally. (28:9-15)

II. GOD'S MERCY CHANGES US (1 PET. 1:3-4)

- A. Our salvation came as a gift of mercy and represents a new birth, a <u>changing</u> of who we are. (1:3)
- B. Our "living hope" is based on the living <u>resurrected</u> Jesus. (1:3)
- C. Our inheritance is death-proof, sin-proof, and time-proof. (1:4)

III. CHANGED HEART/CHANGED LIFE (ROM. 10:9-11)

Salvation comes by grace through faith:

- A. You believe in your <u>heart</u> that Jesus died for your sins and God raised Jesus from the dead. (10:9)
- B. You receive His righteousness.(10:10)
- C. You confess with your **mouth** that Jesus Christ is your Lord openly and without shame.(10:9-11)
