Reported by Herod as raised from the dead (6:14)	Reported by young man as raised from the dead (16:6–7)
Sent for by Herod (6:17, 27)	Sends the Twelve (6:7)
"arrest" and "bind" used of John (6:17)	"arrest" and "bind" used of Jesus (14:1, 44, 46,49; 15:1)
Suffers under reluctant ruler at feast time (6:21, 26)	Suffers under reluctant ruler at feast time (15:1–15)
Herod considers John holy and righteous (6:20)	Pilates considers Jesus not to have been an evildoer (15:14)
Ruler afraid of John (6:20)	Rulers afraid of Jesus (11:18)
Referred to as Elijah (9:11–13)	Referred to as Elijah (6:14–16; 8:27–28)
Buried in tomb by disciples (6:29)	Buried in tomb by a "disciple" (15:42–46)
